



Management and dissemination of grant funding

The Southern African Regional Programme on Access to Medicines and Diagnostics (SARPAM) have engaged GreaterCapital to evaluate and monitor public benefit organisations across Southern Africa as part of their civil society project, Tendai. The Tendai project focuses on monitoring the availability of medicines in eight SADC countries.

Our ongoing fund management and dissemination process has three components:

- Evaluating six public benefit organisations for their ability to implement the Tendai project and their value for money offering.
- Holding funding for the public benefit organisations in a properly regulated trust account for disbursement in tranches (with the necessary accounting control signoffs).
- Monitoring the organisations' implementation and evaluating their progress against pre-determined deliverables as outlined in the grant agreement.

This Southern African programme is being developed in the belief that effective collective action and innovation will improve access to medicines across the regional economic community.
